LGBTQI+ rights: Pride7 to hand its demands to President Macron at the Élysée this Wednesday, 10 June

On the eve of the G7 Summit under the French presidency, Pride7, the international coalition that carries the voice of LGBTQI+ people to the G7, is releasing its official statement and will hand it to President Emmanuel Macron on Wednesday, 10 June at the Élysée.

The message is clear: there is no democracy without the full and complete protection of LGBTQI+ people. As authoritarianism advances and international aid recedes, Pride7 warns of the invisibility of LGBTQI+ populations in development policies and calls on G7 leaders to act.

The statement sets out 26 concrete demands around four priorities: defending democracy and human rights, protecting LGBTQI+ people in humanitarian crises, ensuring fair international aid in the face of the expanding US Global Gag Rules, and securing gender justice and health equity.

Pride7 (P7) is the international coalition that carries the voice of LGBTQI+ people to the G7. Its aim: to bring civil society together so that rights related to sexual orientation, gender identity and gender expression are placed on the agenda of G7 leaders.

France holds the G7 presidency for this summit on 15-17 June. Égides, the French-Canadian LGBTQI NGO that chairs Pride7, will hand these 26 demands to President Macron, together with its international partners, at his invitation to the Élysée on Wednesday, 10 June.
