How to use these captions

These captions are written for partner organizations to amplify Pride 7's communiqué to G7 leaders. **They are starting points, not scripts.**

Three angles are provided so you can pick the one that fits your work:

- Angle A — Aid / development sector
- Angle B — Democracy / human rights
- Angle C — LGBTQI+ rights

The most powerful version is the one in your own voice. Adapt freely. Add your organization's perspective. The campaign's strength comes from many real voices, not from identical reposts.

Publications:

Three angles — pick the one closest to your work.

Angle A — Aid / development sector

Best for: development NGOs, aid coalitions, multilateral institutions, global health organizations.

The international aid system is under attack. Through the expansion of the Global Gag Rules, US foreign assistance is being used to silence civil society, restrict access to care, and pressure sovereign states and multilateral institutions to abandon human rights commitments.

On 15-17 June, the G7 meets in Évian. Pride 7 — the G7 engagement group on LGBTQI+ rights — has published its communiqué calling on leaders to defend the international aid architecture and protect the people it serves.

Angle B — Democracy / human rights

Best for: human rights organizations, civil society networks, democracy and rule-of-law groups.

Democracy depends on the full inclusion and protection of every community.

When governments restrict what civil society can say, defund the institutions that protect minorities, and target trans, nonbinary, and intersex people first — these are not separate attacks. They are the same attack on democratic principles.

On 15-17 June, the G7 meets in Évian. Pride 7's communiqué calls on G7 leaders to defend democracy, human rights, and the international aid system.

Angle C — LGBTQI+ rights

Best for: LGBTQI+ organizations, trans / nonbinary / intersex advocacy, queer health and rights networks.

Trans, nonbinary, and intersex people are the first targets of the global rollback of rights. Restrictions on speech, defunding of health services, and the export of anti-DEI policies through foreign aid are reshaping the conditions of LGBTQI+ existence around the world.

On 15-17 June, the G7 meets in Évian. Pride 7 — the G7 engagement group dedicated to our communities — is calling on leaders to explicitly protect the rights of LGBTQI+ people, especially trans, nonbinary, and intersex individuals.

We stand with this call.
